

Brillier Flieger Mechanical Watch Instruction Guide

Thank you for choosing Brillier. Your timepiece is crafted with precision and designed to deliver reliable performance for years to come. This guide explains how to properly operate and care for your Brillier mechanical watch.

Americhron X3.1 Caliber Automatic Movement Instructions

Initial Winding

- Your watch features an FTSUSA made Americhron automatic mechanical movement. caliber X3.1 which is powered by the motion of your wrist. The movement features a 3 Hand display. Prior to setting the time, the automatic movement must be given an initial manual winding to power up the mainspring. Perform approximately 40 clockwise turns of the crown.

Important - Do not force or over-wind the crown, as excessive pressure may damage the movement.

Time Setting

- Gently pull the crown out to set the time.
- Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands to required time.
- Once the time is set, push the crown back into the case .
- Ensure the crown is fully pushed in. In this position the watch operates normally and maintains water resistance.

Mechanical Watch Care

- Wear the watch regularly to maintain power reserve.
- Wind the watch manually if it has stopped.
- Avoid adjusting the date during restricted hours.
- Store the watch in a clean, dry environment when not in use.

Water Resistance

- Always ensure the crown is fully pressed in.
- Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet.

Model Feature Variations

- Some Brillier models may include additional complications such as Moon Phase, Big Date, Dual Time (GMT), or Exhibition Caseback. Refer to the specific instructions included with your model for additional complication adjustments.
